The plenary begins at 07:45 and your display **MUST** be set before this time. All materials **MUST** be removed by 13:30 on Thursday, 4 June.

You are responsible for shipping/receiving of your materials. A drayage company is not contracted for this event.

Workshop attendees will be free to participate in the tabletop displays before and after sessions and during coffee breaks.

TRF, the Workshop sponsor, and the Sonesta Hotel Management cannot guarantee exhibitors against loss or damage of any kind. The tabletop displays are open to common areas and are not in a secure space, so you will not want to leave anything of value.
